BY-LAWS *Revised March 16, 2009*

ARTICLE I

Name, Location, Objective and Mission Statement

Section 1. Name: The name of the Organization/Corporation shall be known as the POQUOSON ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION, INC., hereinafter referred to as PAA.

Section 2. Principal Office: Poquoson Athletic Association, P.O. Box 2366, Poquoson, Virginia, 23662.

Section 3. Objective: The objective for which PAA is organized is set forth in its Articles of Incorporation. The Poquoson Athletic Association was established and exists to provide a quality and efficient organization for the purpose of providing programs and activities for the advancement of Poquoson wrestlers and wrestling.

Section 4. Mission Statement: Our goal is to provide a safe, fun, positive learning environment, and to enable every wrestler as many opportunities as possible to further themselves in this sport as well as in life. We will teach integrity, discipline, competitiveness and fair play. This program will provide self responsibility, cooperation and dedication.

ARTICLE II

Membership and Voting Rights

Section 1. Active Membership and Voting Rights: A voting member and their voting rights will be defined as one of the following:

- A. You must be a parent or guardian of a child in the wrestling program, either youth or high school teams. Regardless of the number of children wrestling in the program, a family would receive one vote per parent or guardian at least 18 years of age.
- B. Lifetime Member.
- C. Volunteer Coaches.
- D. Current Board Members.
- E. Any volunteer that has supported PAA may apply for approval to the Board of Directors for voting privileges. See the Standards of Operating Procedures for volunteer form.
